



RETIRED LIVING FIRE EVACUATION AWARENESS TRAINING

WHAT IS THIS COURSE ABOUT?

In line with the amended Retirement Villages Act, this course is specifically designed to provide a general fire evacuation awareness training for staff members in a retirement village or independent living units co-located with an aged care facility.

Highlighted in this course is a simulated evacuation exercise and the theory and practical use of fire extinguishers.

WHO SHOULD DO THE COURSE?

All staff members in a retired living facility are encouraged to attend this course.

WHAT WILL YOU LEARN?

At the end of the training, you will be equipped to:

- Identify types of emergencies that may occur in the facility.
- Discuss the use of provided emergency alert systems Such as Vital Call and INS Systems
- Identify the role of the Emergency Response team in an emergency
- Identify various human behaviours in emergency situations
- Understand the Classes of fire and selection and use of portable fire fighting equipment
